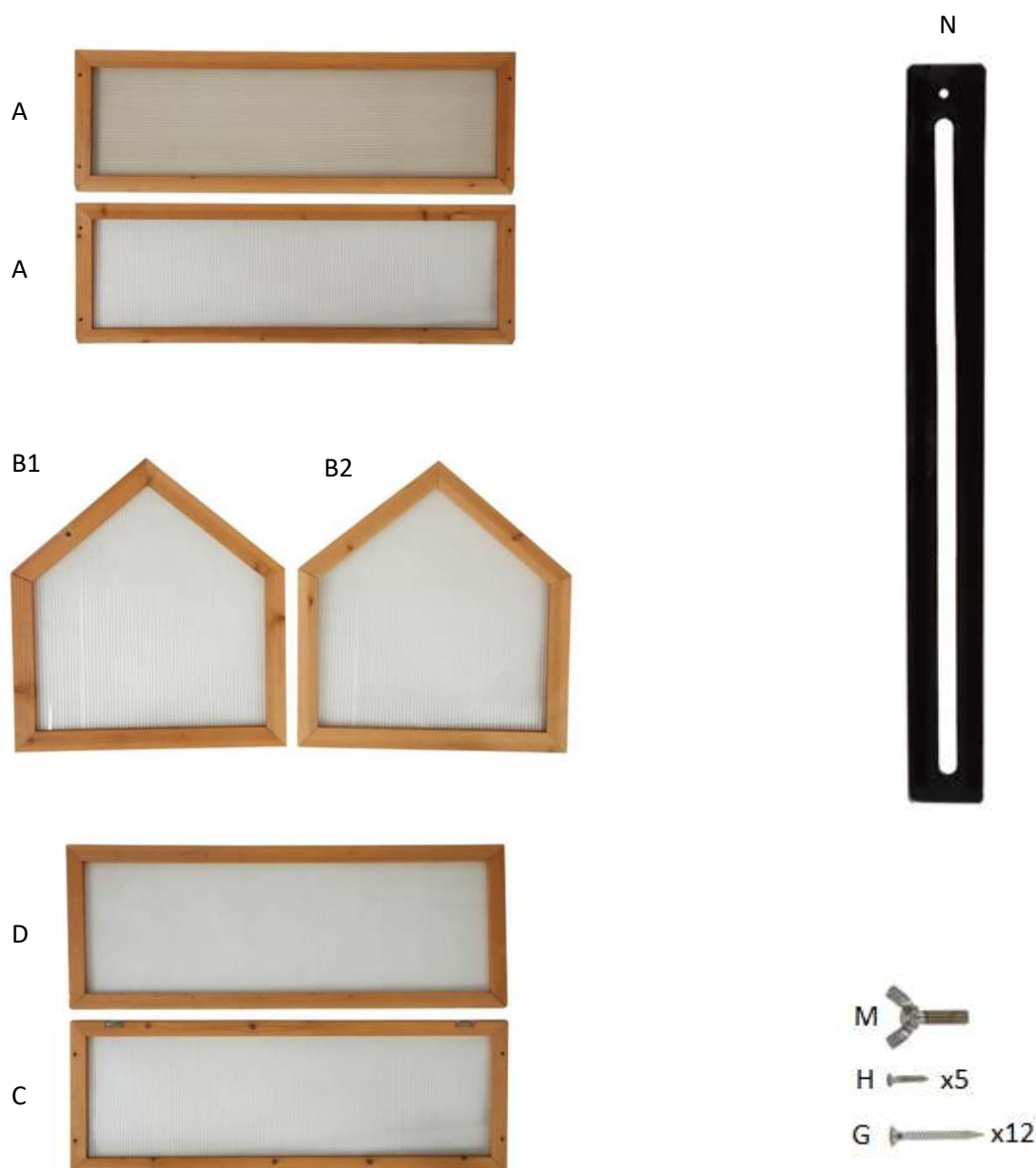

General information and safety warnings

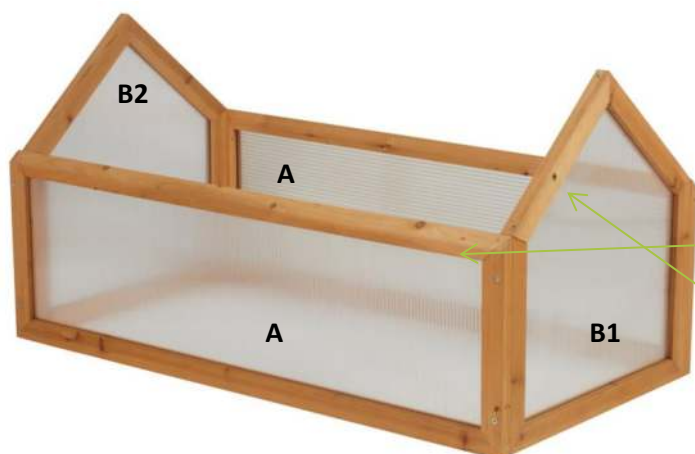
- Keep your plants watered and check on them daily.
- Do not allow children to play in or on the cold frame.
- Do not load on top of the cold frame.
- Assemble on a flat, level surface.
- Never drag the cold frame, always move by carrying equally between two people.
- The cold frame can be secured using simple brackets (not supplied) secured to a solid surface with screws or soft ground with pegs.
- Not suitable for commercial purposes.

Parts list



Make sure that all parts are present before assembly.

Assembly



Make the frame by screwing 2x parts A, B1 and B2 together using screws G.

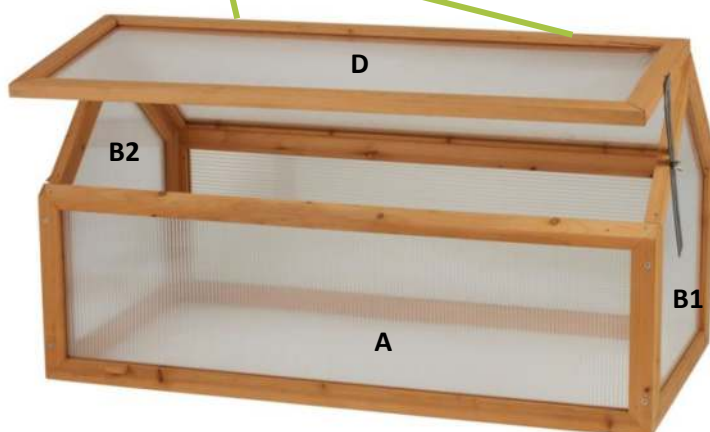
Make sure that the bevelled edge of Sides A face outwards.

On part B1 ensure the hole is in this position facing outwards. This will be used later.



C
(on the top back)

Attach C to B using G screws.

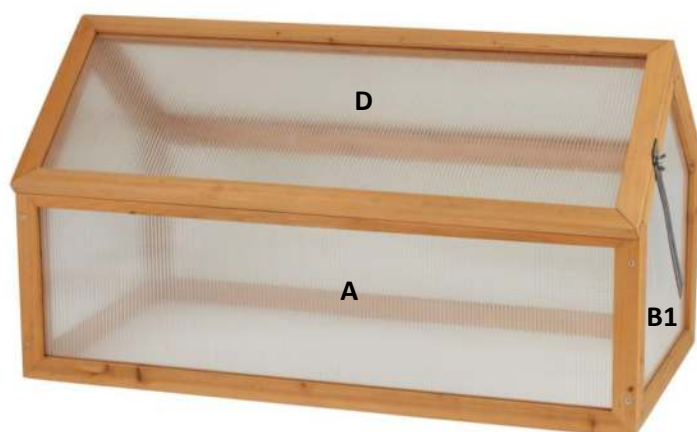


Make sure that the hinges are attached to the outside of the cold frame.

Screw D to the hinges using 4x H screws.

Finally screw part N on to the side of part D using 1x H

screw.



Use screw M to secure the lid to part B1. Loosen the screw to open and close the lid.

Tighten the screw to hold the lid open in the desired position.

Your cold frame is now ready for use.

Care and Maintenance

- To prolong the life of the cold frame, periodically clean the frame and polycarbonate panels with hot soapy water and dry thoroughly.
- The wood has not been pre-treated and would benefit from yearly wood preservative treatment.
- The cold frame is designed to protect young seedlings or cover vegetables and flower beds to extend the growing season.
- Find a sunny yet sheltered location in your garden for your cold frame.
- Check plants in your cold frame daily, keep your plants watered.
- Ventilation is important: even in early spring heat may build up quickly in the cold frame. Remember to open the cold frame to allow ventilation.
- Remember to close the frame during the evening and overnight to protect young and delicate plants from frosts.
- If you feel the need to secure the cold frame to the ground; after-market brackets can be purchased from local DIY stores or builders' merchants. Standard 'L-brackets' can be attached to the sides which will then allow you to secure to the ground (by tying, pegging or screwing).
